A HISTORY OF CRAIGVILLE

- 1871 The New England Convention of Christian Churches votes to establish a Camp Meeting at the Perry Farm in Barnstable.
- 1872 Christian Camp Meeting Association (CCMA) is formed. First ten-day camp meeting is held at Camp Christian at Perry Farm. Group sets up tents for sleeping, eating, and worshiping. Dr. Austin Craig is the leader of the group.
- 1882 Craigville is named for Dr. Austin Craig after his death.
- 1888 800 feet of beach property purchased.
- 1923 Craigville Visitor established.
- 1924 Town takes 168 feet of Beach by eminent domain.
- 1931 Merger of Christian and Congregation Churches. Grove cottage given to Association by Dr. Charles A. Groves.
- 1945 Current beach houses are built.
- 1950 Beach parking lot purchased.
- 1956 Stained glass window installed in Tabernacle chancel.
- 1958 Stained glass window installed over Tabernacle door.
- 1960 Massachusetts Conference, United Church of Christ, leases property. **Craigville Chronicle** established.
- 1962 Manor and Lodge acquired. Year-round programs accommodated.
- 1972 Centennial Celebration
- 2015 United Camps, Conferences, and Retreats (UCCR) was hired to manage the Craigville Retreat Center.
- The Craigville Inn was insulated and had heat and air conditioning installed.
- 2018 A handicap bedroom and bathroom were built on the first floor of the Inn. The interior of the Inn was painted. New lighting was installed in the Tabernacle. The library and the Sunday School rooms were painted.
- New rugs installed in the Tabernacle. Inn Dining Room renovated.
- 2022 Sesquicentennial Celebration
